#### Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 492  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/18/2013 AGENDA - Requires district attorney to disclose to defendant data, documents, tangible objects or information that reasonably appears to be favorable to defendant with respect to determination of guilt, preliminary matter or sentence to be imposed.
- SB 695  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/12/2013 AGENDA - Modifies provisions relating to mandamus actions.
- SB 697  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/12/2013 AGENDA - Prohibits person not licensed to perform tattooing from possessing equipment used for tattooing with intent to use that equipment on another person.
- SB 694  
Requires law enforcement agency to alter police vehicle so that it no longer resembles police vehicle before selling transferring title.
- SB 787  
Authorizes cities and school districts to use cameras to record drivers failing to obey traffic control devices that are mounted on school buses.
