WHAT THE BILL DOES: Consolidates provisions relating to the Oregon Health Licensing Agency's authority and fees over certificates, permits, licenses and registrations. Makes other modifications to provisions relating to the Oregon Health Licensing Agency, and boards and councils administered by the agency. Becomes operative on January 1, 2014. Takes effect on passage.
