To the House Committee on Transportation and Economic Development:

With regards to HB 2301, State Treasury staff have expressed a concern with regards to Section 2(2) of the bill, which explicitly spells out debt capacity practices.

Treasury staff recommend a more generic phrasing such as: "in keeping with the recommendations of the State Debt Policy Advisory Commission with regards to General Fund and Lottery-backed debt capacity" to allow for flexibility over time. A citation to ORS 286A.255 (which outlines the SDPAC Annual Report) would be sufficient.

We understand that the stakeholders on this bill intend to work on these amendments. Considering that, the State Treasury has no objections to this Committee taking action on this bill at this time.
