Hypothetically, if the wrong people were in charge in Lane County and they decide all pesticides should be banned then over half of my farm's yields would drop 50 to 75 %. If that happens over all the conventionally farmable soil in the county it eventually affects the county tax base also

Local control is good for schools, water districts etc but not for pesticides. Driving across county line shouldn't change good farming practices. I urge you to vote "No".
