During the most recent year, 2012, we had 480 appointments and served 244 different individuals. Material assistance was provided, as 2,635 items were given to help parents care for their newborns. We provide classes on Goal setting, decision making skills, parenting, budgeting, and life skills. All of our services are free.

We are seen as a valuable resource by our community and other helping agencies. Many clients are referred to us by their doctors, clinics, county agencies and other resource centers. Many of our clients are referred to us by friends and family members who have benefited from our services.
