Oregon Interfaith Letter to the Oregon Legislature A Call for Action on the Problem of Wage Theft

February 11, 2013

Dear Oregon Legislator,

As Oregon faith leaders and members of Oregon's diverse faith communities, we are deeply concerned about wage theft in our state. We write to urge you to support legislation in 2013 that will hold employers, employment agencies, and labor brokers accountable for wage theft violations, and that will help all workers get paid the wages they have earned.

Wage theft, the underpayment or nonpayment of wages earned, not only violates the law, it transgresses basic moral principles. Jewish and Christian scripture are unequivocal: "Thou shalt not steal." From Deuteronomy 24:15, we read: "You must pay out the wages due on the same day, before the sun sets, for the worker is needy and urgently depends on it." And the Prophet Muhammad was clear: "Pay the worker while the sweat is still wet upon their brow."

During a recent five-year period, Oregon workers filed over 8,500 wage claims for \$24.5 million in unpaid wages with the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), according to research conducted by the Oregon Center for Public Policy. Such complaints represent only a fraction of all violations. Many workers whose wages are stolen stay silent. They fear employer retaliation, do not know where to turn, or have little hope that anything can be done.

In Woodburn, for example, a group of sixteen workers received almost no pay for two months of grueling painting and cleaning work. Their stolen wages are estimated to total almost \$80,000, but their direct employer has disappeared without compensating them.

While wage theft is common across many industries, it disproportionately affects low-wage workers – those most likely to be living paycheck to paycheck. And, wage theft does not just affect the workers whose wages are stolen. It corrodes the health and wellbeing of our communities and society as a whole.

We give thanks for employers who act with justice and fairness toward their workers. Their good citizenship is undermined when competing employers are allowed to violate the law without being held accountable.

We urge you to take action to address wage theft in 2013. Our shared religious, ethical, and legal principles require nothing less.

Thank you for your work on these difficult issues.
