- Enforces the Oregon Medical Practice Act
- Licenses and regulates the professions of medical doctor, doctor of osteopathy, podiatrist, physician assistant, and acupuncturist.

- Other Fund revenues for licensing and other services are paid by licensees and fund the agency functions:
 - Licensing
 - Investigations and Compliance
 - Education
 - Administration

Oregon Medical Board 2013-15 Governor's Budget Overview



- Includes an increase to the renewal fee for licensees.
- Establishes a fee for criminal background checks.
 - The Board implemented fingerprint background checks during the 2005-07 biennium. There was previously no associated fee.
- Includes a one time surcharge for physician assistants and an ongoing supervising physician application fee.
 - Recovers costs and aligns ongoing fees with the requirements of Senate Bill 224 (2011)

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- Investment in continued participation in the Health Professionals' Services Program.
- Standard Adjustments:
 - Updates to DAS Price List and State Government Services Charges, placeholder for Statewide Administrative Savings, PERS Rate and PERS Policy adjustments.
