Oregon Health Authority Medical Assistance Programs



- Access to transformed health care system
 - Expands coverage through federal Affordable Care Act
- Limited cost growth per capita to 4.4 and 3.4 percent per the agreement with Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
- Continues and expands hospital assessment
- Sunsets insurance premium assessment
- Health System Transformation Fund

Oregon Health Authority Private Health Partnerships



- The Office of Private Health Partnerships
 - Informs and assists Oregonians in making informed health insurance choices.
 - Administers programs that work to break down barriers to health care access.
 - Assists with health care costs.
 - Preserve the participation of insurers in the children's insurance market.
 - Educates program members and the general public about the changes in the health care system.



Oregon Health Authority Private Health Partnerships - Revenue



- The Office of Private Health Partnerships is funded by a combination of:
 - o General Fund
 - Other Funds from the final three months of insurers tax, enrollee premiums, and assessments on licensed Oregon commercial health insurers
 - o Matching Federal Funds





Oregon Health Authority Private Health Partnerships



• The Office of Private Health Partnerships

- The Family Health Insurance Assistance Program, the Oregon Medical Insurance Pool, and the Federal Medical Insurance Pool are all scheduled to be phased out with the implementation of the Federal Affordable Care Act.
- Healthy Kids Connect is forecasted to expand as a result of the Federal Affordable Care Act.
 - **×** Backfill of Insurers Tax with General Fund.

Oregon Health Authority Public Employees Benefit Board



- Public Employees Benefit Board
 - Designs, contracts, and administers high-quality health plans, group insurance, and flexible spending accounts for state employees and their dependents.
 - Other Fund revenues from premiums charged to agencies universities and self pay members.







Oregon Health Authority Public Employees Benefit Board



• Increase in Other Funds non-limited for the Health Engagement Model (HEM) subsidy payments.

Oregon Health Authority Oregon Educators Benefit Board



- Oregon Educators Benefit Board
 - Provides high-quality medical, dental and other benefit plans for educational entities throughout Oregon.
 - Other Fund revenues from the collection of premiums, which includes an assessment to cover the agency's administration expense.







Oregon Health Authority Oregon Educators Benefit Board



- Reflects administering the Home Healthcare Workers program.
 - Increase to Other Funds Limited and three full time positions.
 - Increase to Other Funds Non-Limited
