If your house is on fire, if you are having a heart attack, if your car has broken down in the fast lane of I-5 during rush hour you are having an emergency. Amending ORS 390.805 to 390.925 by designating a plethora of additional waterways in Oregon as "Scenic" is not, may I repeat **NOT**, an emergency. The only emergency surrounding SB 401 will be the devastating impact it will have on private property owners that own property within the areas designated to be added under SB 401.

Our great country was founded on the belief that everyone is endowed with the right to Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness, which means acquiring and possessing property, and pursuing and obtaining happiness and safety thereon. Apparently the authors of SB 401 do not believe in these rights of individuals and want to deprive the private property owners within the areas added under SB 401 of these rights.
