Co-Chairs Edwards, Unger and Members of the Subcommittee,

My name is Ian Fergusson. I am a volunteer member of the board of directors of the Association of Northwest Steelheaders. Our organization's interest in forest policy stems from the close relationship between forest practices and aquatic ecosystems.

We wish to testify in general support of the Department of Forestry, and the diversification of revenue sources to help ensure fiscal stability. There are two Policy Option Packages that we think are of particular importance.

Policy Option Package 452 provides funding for the Department to continue its long-term studies on forest practices and water quality. We believe this is a critical component of the mission of the Department of Forestry. There is no shortage of opinions about forest practices, but decisions must be driven by data. Such data cannot be gathered cheaply or rapidly. We respectfully ask that you support this package.

Policy Option Package 453 provides funding for administration of the Forest Practices Act. This function has been severely curtailed in the recent economic downturn. The package would put more Stewardship Foresters on the ground to help ensure that habitat and water quality are protected during road construction and timber harvest. We respectfully ask that you support this package.
