Oregon Health Authority Caseload Update

Oregon Health Plan (OHP) Spring 2013 shows changes in caseload that will cost \$17.2M General Fund.

OHP increased costs are off-set by savings (FMAP rate changes, CHIPRA Bonus)

Addictions and Mental Health (AMH) Spring 2013 caseload changes show significant reductions over the Fall forecast.

With Affordable Care Act (ACA) in January 2014 comes largest national health policy change since beginning of Medicaid program in 1965. This will make ability to forecast future Medicaid caseloads very difficult.
