




Fire suppression effectiveness

*Current performance measure


2012 Fire Season








Initial Attack Barry Point Fire

- Team order and delegation
- Team reports to Agency Administrator(s)
- Agency Administrator | representative
- Operations Advisor
- IMT resource orders directed to ODF
- Local resources support with IA priorities

- Landowner communication, coordination and integration
- Incident Management Team ordering
- Delegation of authority
- Interagency IMTs Augmenting the Organization
- Resource value on private
- Federal forest management and fire policy
