




Your County Road Dollars At Work \$670 Million Replacement Value

SUMMARY

- 1. Majority of expenditures are reactive maintenance
- 2. Vegetation management (spraying) is the only preventative maintenance program
- 3. All resources are now allocated to reacting to potholes, bridge maintenance, culverts & guardrails
- 4. <u>Our County Road System</u> may be turned around in 10 years with well planned expenditures of additional local revenue.




Ok, so What have you done to try an fix the problem and what are your plans for the future?

We elected you to provide leadership. Where is the leadership?

We have put before the voters four ballot measures beginning as far back as 1996.

- 1996 four cent gas tax increase. Failed with 66% voting NO
- 1999 five yr. 85 cent property tax increase. Failed with 64% voting NO
- 2008 form a road dist. With a \$1.00 assessment. Failed with 65% NO
- 2011 46 cent general obligation bond that would bring in 15 million.
 Failed with 53% No
