Chair and members of the committee,

My name is Don Poole. I am a citizen of the United States, a resident of Oregon and I live in Salem. I pay taxes and therefore, I pay your wages. You represent me and other citizens, NOT those illegally in this country.

I do <u>not</u> want <u>my</u> tax monies to be spent to create drivers' licenses for illegals.
