Please oppose the above referred bill because there have been too many examples of election offices inefficiencies to expect competence from agencies with other priorities;

Here are some examples:

Just recently 444 Voter Notification cards were mailed to incorrect addresses in Multnomah County. Those cards make the people to whom they should have been sent (unclear why) vulnerable to identity theft. It is to be hoped that each of these people have been issued a letter from the election office, alerting them to this potential problem.

In 2012 a 1000 voters received ballots which couldn't be voted on, because they were an incorrect ballots style. To say the least it caused confusion, delays and unnecessary costs.

The same Voter Notification cards are being issued to voter registration applicants who have failed to provide any proof of identiity. Since these are government documents they can falsely be used both in and out of Oregon as an identity credential, since there is no warning indicating that the card does NOT guarantee the recipient's identity.

There are also deceased voters on the electoral roll, that are still being sent ballots and votes have been cast for them. Regrettably there is reliance on DMV records, which probably wont be fully reliable for at least a couple more years due to the largest Immigration Fraud in Oregon history uncovered in 2003. It was revealed via testimony from DMV officials during the trials in 2005 & 2006 that a high percentage of the fraudulent records were destroyed.

In closing, the emphasis for now should be improve the efficiency of the electoral system and avoid the confusion of relying on other agencies whose staff have other duty priorities.
