Oregon Health Authority Public Health - Revenue



- The Office of Public Health is funded by a combination of:
  - o General Fund
  - Other Funds licenses, fees, tobacco taxes, and provider taxes
  - Federal Funds grant and matching funds



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- Specific programs continue to receive partial funding from medical marijuana fees
- Assumed sunset of insurers tax
   Backfill of insurers tax with General Fund
- Linking specific programs to early learning
