

Reentry Enhancement Coordination Program Outcomes Overview

Multnomah County Community Justice is a Reentry Program partnering with:

VOA for Treatment
Bridges To Change for Housing and Peer Mentorship
SE Works for Employment Development

Served 450 Offenders over the last four years

Recidivism Results:

Control Group
Arrest = 28%

Reentry Grant Programs
All Arrests= 16%
(213 clients)

Recidivism Difference of =43.3%

Employment Outcome:

Achieving employment within 90 days of release = 74%

Housing Outcome:

Achieving independent housing after 90 days of Prison release = 84%

Cost Benefit REC Program

Benefit to Cost Ratio= **\$6.73**

****Every \$1 spent on REC Program = benefit of \$6.73**

Cost of Reentry Program Per Participant= \$3,419

System & Tax Payer Cost Avoided= \$8,631

Crime Victims Cost Avoided= **\$14,388**

Costs Avoided Per Participant= Total \$23,019
