Multnomah County Community Justice is a Reentry Program partnering with:

VOA for Treatment Bridges To Change for Housing and Peer Mentorship SE Works for Employment Development

Served 450 Offenders over the last four years

**Recidivism Results:** 

**Control Group** Arrest = 28% Reentry Grant Programs All Arrests= 16% (213 clients)

Recidivism Difference of =43.3%

**Employment Outcome:** 

Achieving employment within 90 days of release = 74%

**Housing Outcome:** 

Achieving independent housing after 90 days of Prison release = 84%

<u>Cost Benefit REC Program</u> Benefit to Cost Ratio= **\$6.73** \*\*Every \$1 spent on REC Program = benefit of \$6.73

Cost of Reentry Program Per Participant=\$3,419System & Tax Payer Cost Avoided=\$8,631Crime Victims Cost Avoided=\$14,388Costs Avoided Per Participant= Total \$23,019
