Members of the Committee:

My name is Tim Kral and I have been the Executive Director of Oregon Rehabilitation Association for the past 28 years. Our membership is comprised of nonprofits that provide homes and jobs to thousands of people with disabilities in virtually every community in the state.

I was invited to participate with the committee that Representative Nathanson convened over the past 18 months to review current issues with criminal background checks and propose solutions. Actually, Representative Nathanson convened the committee in a direct response to concerns expressed by Eugene ORA members in a meeting at the Pearl Buck Center. We, like all human service agencies, have been frustrated by the multiple checks required on the same person and other cumbersome and unnecessary requirements.

We believe this bill would create a more streamlined, centralized system that will function better not only for the employee, but also the provider and ultimately the vulnerable population ORA members serve.

We commend Representative Nathanson for her efforts and urge the Committee to unanimously recommend this bill for passage.
