## Subject: Senate Bills 439 and 440

Senator Monnes-Anderson and Members of the Committee,

My name is Lisa Dodson. I am a family physician, Director of the Oregon Area Health Education Center, board member and Secretary of the Oregon Academy of Family Physicians, board member of the Oregon Rural Health Association, and current Chair of the Oregon Health Policy Board's Healthcare Workforce Committee, I am here today to provide information in support of SB439 and SB440.

Meaningful access to health care in a reformed health care system will be impossible to achieve without an adequate supply of primary care providers, who act as points of entry into the health care system. Equally important is ensuring that Oregon's primary care physicians and other care providers have the ability and capacity to transform our current healthcare system from a "sick care system" to a medical home model that meets the Triple Aim of improved access, improved outcomes and quality, and lower cost. Oregon does not educate enough health care providers in many key professions and is therefore a net importer of physicians and many other health professionals. Recruitment of these health professionals is now occurring in a national and even international marketplace, and we must be competitive to secure the workforce needed to manage our healthcare transformation.

A health care workforce that reflects the ethnic, cultural, geographic and economic diversity is also essential to achieving the Triple Aim. Data indicates that the rising cost of health care education in nursing, dentistry, medicine, physician assistant and pharmacy programs is increasingly driving students away from selecting primary care careers and care to underserved populations. OHSU tuition is among the highest in the country in each of these disciplines. Nationally and in Oregon we are experiencing a loss of the essential primary care providers that will be critically important to serving the expanded insured population in 2014. The most recent data from a study to be released this week by the Oregon Healthcare Workforce Institute indicates a loss of more than 300 primary care providers in the last biennium as reported by Oregon's healthcare licensing boards. This loss is expected to accelerate as the retirement of "baby boomer" health care workers accelerates in this decade, further exacerbating the recruitment problem.



Effective, sustainable recruitment of all types of health care workers requires a measured, committed approach. Loan repayment is one well documented and effective factor in recruitment, particularly of providers currently outside the state, and the organizations I represent encourage the Committee and the Oregon Legislature to move quickly to fund a robust loan repayment program targeted to primary care practitioners willing to serve in rural and underserved communities. A two year loan repayment program, regardless of its scope and funding, will not be sufficient, however. A loan repayment program, thoughtfully combined with other methods of recruitment and retention such as continued funding of the Oregon Primary Care Loan Forgiveness program enacted in the 2011 legislative session (\$500,000 for the biennium), with a plan for coordination and sustainability beyond 2 years, will be essential. Each element of these recruitment packages are important and serve different purposes, and like a three legged stool, will only work with a proper balance of all three. Legislative intent should be clear and precise and serve as a guide to Oregon's health professions training programs. For example, programs receiving state funding could be required to demonstrate effectiveness at producing the workforce needed for Oregon communities. Scholarships, loan forgiveness and loan repayment programs each contribute in different ways:

- **Loan repayment:** recruits providers ready for practice. Quick, but may attract providers who are less likely to remain in Oregon or in underserved community after period of obligated service
- Loan forgiveness: reduces the upfront debt load of students, thereby facilitating specialty and practice choices toward less economically favorable but needed specialties such as primary care and rural practice. Benefits current Oregon students, increases opportunity for diverse Oregon students.
- **Scholarships**: serve to recruit students with specific characteristics (underrepresented minority, geographic or economic backgrounds) who would otherwise not attend OHSU due to receiving better incentives elsewhere.

I encourage you to consider a sustainable approach that encompasses loan repayment as a necessary but not sufficient component of an overall plan for recruitment incentives. An effective plan will include an array of options such as those above; utilize data collected during each biennium to demonstrate sustainability and effectiveness; and encourage retention of practitioners.

Enclosed for your review is a partial listing (not comprehensive) of loan repayment, forgiveness and scholarship programs from around the country against which we are essentially competing.
