SUMMARY

Requires State Department of Energy to study certain issues related to energy use.

Sunsets January 2, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to energy; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Department of Energy, after consultation 5 with the Department of Environmental Quality, shall undertake a 6 study of energy use in Oregon in relation to carbon sequestration. The 7 study must include an analysis of the per capita energy use in Oregon 8 from sources of green energy, including solar, wind, geothermal and 9 hydropower.

(2) The State Department of Energy shall report the results of the
study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related
to environment and natural resources on or before November 1, 2013.

13 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
