Subject:HB 2259 Relating to Fees Charged by the Water ResourcesDepartment Work Session Recommendations

Hb 2259 authorizes the Water Resources Department to adopt rules to increase fees by the lesser of two percent per year or percent increase in the consumer price index since the previous fee increase. The measure has an emergency clause and is effective on passage.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, preliminary Joint Committee on Ways and Means staff measure summary, revenue impact statement [if available], and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

The measure was referred by the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources by prior reference.

The measure has a \$996,211 and 7 full-time equivalent positions fiscal impact, one position less than the current service funding level.

### Amendment A-5

There is a -5 amendment to the measure that provides for a 3.25 percent per year increase or Consumer Price Index (CPI) whichever is greater starting in 2009 and a 2 percent per year increase or CPI whiehever is greater starting July 1, 2015. The fiscal impact is \$1,076,003 maintaining current service level funding for the 2013-15 biennium and \$1,119,043 for the 2015-17 biennium.
