Subject: SB 306-A Work Session Recommendations

SB 306-A requires the Legislative Revenue Office to prepare a report on the feasibility of imposing a clean air fee or tax on a statewide basis. The bill requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to provide a preliminary report to the Legislature no later than December 1, 2013 and final report no later than November 15, 2014. The bill also authorizes the Legislative Revenue Officer to contract with third parties to prepare the report.

The –A14 amendment, the original staff measure summary, revenue impact statement, and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure history is also available on OLIS.

The measure has a \$200,000 to \$300,000 fiscal impact to the Legislative Revenue Office to complete the study.

<u>Amendment</u>

There is a –A14 amendment to the measure adds a \$200,000 General Fund appropriation to the Legisltive Revenue Office to complete the study.
