**WHAT THE BILL DOES**: Extends the sunset of the Small School District Grants by five years to June 30, 2018. Specifies that, starting from the 2013-14 school year, transportation for a student enrolled in an eligible day treatment program be provided by a school district where the student is a resident.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Funds and grants available for small schools
- Foreign exchange students as resident students in some school districts

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:** Specifies that transportation for a student enrolled in an eligible day treatment program be provided by a school district where the student is a resident.

**BACKGROUND:** Small school districts with small high schools defined in the ORS 327.355 receive their respective prorated shares of the Small School District Grants of \$2.5 million per school year. The current law regarding the grants is set to be repealed on June 30, 2013.
