Board of Pharmacy Agency Overview



 Promotes, preserves and protects the public welfare by establishing high standards in the practice of pharmacy and distribution of pharmaceutical products in Oregon.

• The Board:

- Enforces the Oregon Pharmacy Act
- Licenses drug distributers and wholesalers and manufacturers of drugs





Board of Pharmacy Revenue Sources



- Other Fund revenues for licensing and other services are paid by licensees and fund the agency divisions:
 - Licensing
 - Compliance
 - Administration

Board of Pharmacy 2013-15 Governor's Budget/Technical Adjustments



- Investment to meet growing demands +\$299,633
 Reclassifies two positions upward and adds 1.25 FTE.
- Investment in paperless record retention +\$85,000
 Phase one of scanning documents for records retention.

• Fee Increase

- Forecasted to generate additional revenues of \$1,431,200.
- Increases licensing fees for wholesalers and manufacturers from \$400 to \$800.
- Contingent in part on SB 106.

• House Bill 5037

• Approves the establishment of supervising physician dispensing outlet fee of \$300.
