## SUMMARY

Authorizes inclusion of urban reserve land controlled by large industrial employer within urban growth boundary.

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- 2 Relating to inclusion of land within urban growth boundary for industrial
- 3 use; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 197.626.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part
- 6 of ORS 197.295 to 197.314.
- SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 197.296 and 197.298, a city may
- 8 include within its urban growth boundary up to 100 acres of land des-
- 9 ignated urban reserve under ORS 195.145 (1)(a) without evaluating al-
- 10 ternative boundary locations pursuant to a statewide land use
- 11 planning goal relating to urbanization when:
- 12 (a) An employer of 50 or more full-time equivalent employees owns,
- 13 or has an enforceable option to purchase, the land;
- (b) The employer is engaged in an industrial use reflecting an eco-
- 15 nomic development opportunity that is demonstrably consistent with
- 16 the economic opportunities analysis in the acknowledged comprehen-
- 17 sive plan of the city; and
- 18 (c) The employer has a plan to expand operations and employment
- 19 on the land.
- 20 (2) If the city amends the urban growth boundary to include land
- 21 under subsection (1) of this section, the city shall establish a compre-

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- 1 hensive plan designation for the land that allows zoning of the land
- 2 for uses that are:
- 3 (a) Consistent with the industrial use planned by the employer; and
- 4 (b) Similar in nature and type to, or complementary to, the indus-
- 5 trial use planned by the employer.
- 6 **SECTION 3.** ORS 197.626 is amended to read:
- 7 197.626. (1) A local government shall submit for review and the Land
- 8 Conservation and Development Commission shall review the following final
- 9 land use decisions in the manner provided for review of a work task under
- 10 ORS 197.633:
- 11 (a) An amendment of an urban growth boundary by a metropolitan service
- 12 district that adds more than 100 acres to the area within its urban growth
- 13 boundary;
- 14 (b) An amendment of an urban growth boundary by a city with a popu-
- 15 lation of 2,500 or more within its urban growth boundary that adds more
- 16 than 50 acres to the area within the urban growth boundary, unless the
- 17 amendment is authorized by section 2 of this 2013 Act;
- 18 (c) A designation of an area as an urban reserve under ORS 195.137 to
- 19 195.145 by a metropolitan service district or by a city with a population of
- 20 2,500 or more within its urban growth boundary;
- 21 (d) An amendment of the boundary of an urban reserve by a metropolitan
- 22 service district;
- 23 (e) An amendment of the boundary of an urban reserve to add more than
- 24 50 acres to the urban reserve by a city with a population of 2,500 of more
- 25 within its urban growth boundary; and
- 26 (f) A designation or an amendment to the designation of a rural reserve
- 27 under ORS 195.137 to 195.145 by a county, in coordination with a metropol-
- 28 itan service district, and the amendment of the designation.
- 29 (2) A final order of the commission under this section may be appealed
- 30 to the Court of Appeals in the manner described in ORS 197.650 and 197.651.

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
