On behalf of the Oregon Blueberry industry and its 315 producers, we would like to convey our support for the Oregon Department of Agriculture and its proposed budget that will be up for consideration by your Committee.

The blueberry industry is one of agriculture's most impressive success stories, with a value that now exceeds \$100 million. The Oregon Department of Agriculture has very much been a part of this success, often leading the way in helping develop new export markets. In 2012 Oregon was the first production region in the world that was granted access to export fresh blueberries to South Korea, very much the envy of our national industry.

The South Korean market would not be open to Oregon producers without the foresight and determination of ODA's Marketing and Commodity Inspection Divisions. Chile, Canada, Washington and California are all following our lead and trying to achieve what we've accomplished.
