The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department manages state parks, acquires additional state park lands, protects Oregon's ocean shores and scenic waterways, and works with the all-terrain vehicles community. The Oregon State Fair was added to the Department's portfolio in 2005. The Department also oversees heritage conservation in the state.

Budget Notes: The following budget note was included in Parks' budget bill in 2011.

SB 5534 (Chapter 584, Oregon Laws of 2011)

The approved budget provides resources for the management, operation, and maintenance of state park lands and facilities. It is the Legislature's expectation that any actions taken by the Oregon Parks Commission regarding land management, including providing access by easement, will take into consideration community issues and concerns, protection of the natural resource, and public values.
