# Department of Education Revenue Sources



- General Fund: 77% of budget, including 95% of SSF
- Lottery Funds: debt service on bonds and 5% of SSF
- Other Funds: from variety of sources including fees and grants
- Federal Funds: 12% of budget; ESEA and IDEA grants
- Non-Limited OF: Common School Fund
- Non-Limited FF: USDA Nutrition programs
