Board of Accountancy Agency Overview



- The Board of Accountancy protects the public by regulating the practice and performance of all services provided by licensed accountants.
 - Evaluates qualifications for initial licensing
 - Monitors the continuing education of licensees
 - Responds to and investigates complaints





Board of Accountancy Revenue Sources

- The Board is 100%Other Funded
- 92% of revenues are generated from licensures, business registrations fees, and examination fees
- Policy Package 100 includes additional revenue of \$83,650
