- 20% of the budget is for services and supplies rent and utilities and telecommunications, State Government Service Charges, expendable property, professional services and training, etc.



Oregon State Police Revenue Sources



Agency fund types

- General Fund majority of agency funding
- Lottery Funds transfer from Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, supports Fish and Wildlife Division
- Other Funds transfers from other agencies (e.g., from Department of Fish and Wildlife), various charges for services, Fire Marshal fees, licenses and fees
- Federal Funds grants and contracts (e.g., agreements with NOAA, BPA, & BLM for Fish and Wildlife Division protection)



Investments

 Transfer State Police's Wireless Program staff, operations, and related funding to Department of Transportation's State Radio Project
