Measure Description:

Directs Early Learning Council and Department of Education to assist school districts in implementing process to assess children to determine their readiness for kindergarten.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Early Learning Council, School Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill [may] [does not] affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill directs the Early Learning Council and Oregon Department of Education to assist school districts in assessing children’s readiness for kindergarten. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
