- Miscellaneous issues
 - × Increase Common School Fund program expenditure level to cover property tax on former Eugene Motor Pool property.
 - × South Slough National Research Reserve
 - Program efficiencies self-funded position reclassifications
 - Watershed stewardship implement forest management, climate change and watershed management plans.
 - Capital improvements to protect asset values Salem headquarters heating and ventilation system.

- Revenue shortfalls
 - South Slough National Estuarine Research Reserve Federal Funds projected to be less than in past biennia.

Post-publication issues
