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What Works

- Student engagement is front and foremost. We began the year with a face-to-face orientation with students and families. Teachers spent the part of the day in "get acquainted" activities, making those personal connections. Each student was contacted by phone before school started, again to build relationships. All staff members communicate regularly with students by phone, email or through message and discussion boards through our student Learning Management System. Parents and students have both commented that they have received much more teacher one-on-one contact time than in a "brick and mortar" school. Some of our students have joined Hillsboro Online because they felt "lost at school".
- Our curriculum is outstanding and highly regarded across the Nation. It is already aligned to the Common Core in Math and work is being



completed in English courses as well. Staff members participated in three full days of training in how to be an online teacher and are continuing to participate in online learning Webinars as well as "real time" training provided by the Oregon Virtual School District. Three staff members attended the iNACOL Virtual Symposium in October; the most highly regarded online education conference in the world.

- Addressing our environment and culture, our site at Peter Boscow was planned with the needs of students foremost. It is equipped with comfortable couches and chairs in warm, welcoming colors. Technology is readily available and easily accessed. Students have access to a refrigerator and microwave and are encouraged to bring their lunch and spend the day. Teachers are in close proximity and accessible to students for assistance. We have "open gym" every Thursday afternoon so students can come together in a supervised activity. Parent support sessions start next week with, "Supporting Your Online Learner". Social activities have taken place, with more planned throughout the year.
