Oregon State Library 2013-15 Governor's Budget Overview



- 2nd year budget subject to reorganization plan:
 - January 2012 Workgroup report recommendations.
 - Budget directs agency reorganization plan by June 2014 to identify essential services, consolidate duplicate services and reduce costs.
 - Reorganization steering committee representation:
 - × State Library
 - × DAS Chief Operating Office
 - **×** SOS Archives Division
 - × Stakeholder advisory councils





Oregon State Library Revenue Sources



- Assessment paid by other state agencies (\$5.3 million)
- Federal Funds: Library Services and Technology Act grants (\$4.8 million)
- Donations (\$0.5 million)
- Miscellaneous receipts (\$0.2 million)
- General Fund (\$1.7 million 1st year only. 2nd year
 @ \$1.7 million is appropriated to the Emergency Fund)

- Place 2nd year funding in the Emergency Fund subject to reorganization plan
