A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to education service districts; amending ORS 334.015; and declaring

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 334.015 is amended to read:

6 334.015. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 334.010 and 334.013, one or more com-7 ponent school districts of an education service district may withdraw from 8 the education service district [*if the component school district is located in:*]

9 [(a) A region described in ORS 334.013 (1)(a), (b), (c) or (p); or]

10 [(b) Baker County].

(2) A school district board may choose to withdraw a school district from 11 an education service district [as provided in subsection (1) of this section] by 12an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the school district board. 13 (3)(a) A school district board that chooses to withdraw a school district 14 from the education service district must submit a notice of intent to with-15draw to the board of directors of the education service district no later than 16 November 1 of the year prior to the year in which the school district plans 17 to withdraw from the education service district. 18

(b) A school district board that submitted a notice of intent to withdrawas provided by paragraph (a) of this subsection must submit a notice of

withdrawal to the board of directors of the education service district no later
than March 1 of the year in which the school district plans to withdraw from
the education service district.

4 (c) Within 60 days of receiving the notice of withdrawal under paragraph
5 (b) of this subsection, the board of directors of the education service district
6 shall issue an order that recognizes the withdrawal of the school district
7 from the education service district.

8 (4) The withdrawal of a school district from an education service district 9 becomes effective on July 1 after the board of directors of the education 10 service district issues the order described in subsection (3) of this section.

11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-12 ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-13 clared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
