WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Continues the obligation of the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC) to train corrections officers. Returns responsibility to Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) on January 2, 2026.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• Corrections officers should not be trained the same way as police officers

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Extends sunset out to January 2, 2026.

BACKGROUND: The 2009 Legislative Assembly transferred the responsibility for training DOC corrections officers from DPSST to DOC. However, this transfer sunsets January 2, 2014. Unless the sunset provision is either removed or extended out, training of corrections officers will revert to DPSST.
