Measure Description:

Allows owner of land to receive liquidated damages in amount not to exceed \$1,000 in action in which owner establishes that owner closed land to specific activities and defendant entered upon land and engaged in prohibited activities without permission of owner.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Forestry, Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA), Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Land Use to the Committee on Rules. The bill allows owner(s) of land to receive liquidated damages in certain cases. Legislative Fiscal Offices anticipates that a fiscal impact may be associated with this bill; the amount of this impact is still being determined.
