WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Directs Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) to study methods of resolving postemployment disputes and report to Legislative Assembly by September 1, 2014. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Opportunity for BOLI to research methods for resolving post-employment disputes such as mediation
- BOLI's resources to spearhead such an effort
- BOLI's current dispute resolution structure
- Use of mediation in California

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The mission of the Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) is to protect employment rights, advance employment opportunities, and protect access to housing and public accommodations free from discrimination.
