**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES**: Adds luring a minor (ORS 167.057), and conspiracy involving a sex crime (ORS 161.450) to the list of crimes defined as "Sex Crimes" for purposes of this section. Gives the Judge discretion whether or not to designate a conviction of luring a minor as a sex crime. Declares emergency, effective upon passage.

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.
