**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Establishes Task Force on Community College Child Care Services (Task Force). Sunsets Task Force on date of convening of 2015 regular session of Legislative Assembly. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Senate

- Need for affordable childcare
- Childcare to include an education component

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 3149 creates the Task Force on Community College Child Care Services to study the cost of providing child care services for community college students and identify potential funding sources. The measure specifies that the membership include community college administrators, faculty, students, board members, the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development (CCWD) and the Child Care Division of the Employment Department. At least two members of the Task Force must be community college faculty and at least two members must be students. Members are to be appointed by the Commissioner for Community College Services and CCWD is directed to provide staff support. The Task Force is directed to report its findings to the interim committee on education no later than September 1, 2014.
