Creates Fish Passage Restoration Subaccount within Fish Passage Fund. Establishes fees for in conduit hydropower projects to be directed to the fund which would be waived upon installation of fish passage.

The in conduit hydropower projects that would be affected by the new fees are considered to be relatively rare, so this portion of the revenue impact is minimal.
