WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Removes requirement that employers of 250 or more full-time employees in Oregon conduct annual earthquake drills in April. Permits annual earthquake drills to be held anytime.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Increased flexibility and local control •
- Earthquake and tsunami awareness and preparation as locally driven efforts. •

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: April is National Earthquake and Tsunami month and therefore was initially designated as the month for earthquake drills. Earthquake and tsunami drills and other preparedness efforts occur year-round in Oregon. House Bill 2183 provides employers with more flexibility when scheduling annual earthquake drills.
