On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 4 through 9 and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 5. ORS 607.992 is amended to read: 3 "607.992. (1) [Violation of any provision of this chapter is a misdemeanor.] A person that intentionally, knowingly or recklessly violates a provision of this chapter is guilty of a Class 4 $\mathbf{5}$ A misdemeanor. 6 "(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, a person that violates a provision of this chapter, but does not act intentionally, knowingly or recklessly, commits a Class B 7 violation. 8 9 "(3)(a) A person that violates ORS 607.045, but does not act intentionally, knowingly or 10 recklessly, commits a Class D violation if the person does not have a previous conviction for a violation of ORS 607.045. As used in this paragraph, 'previous conviction' means a con-11 viction entered before the commission of the current violation of ORS 607.045. 12"(b) Notwithstanding ORS 153.019 or any other requirement pertaining to Class D vio-13 lation fine amounts, the presumptive fine for a violation described in this subsection is 14 \$60.". 15
