SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs each public university to conduct study on how to better use campus resources during summer term and examine benefits of year-round, full-time operation of university.

Sunsets study on January 2, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to study of the operation of public universities; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall conduct a study of how

5 to better use campus resources during the summer term.

6 (2) The study must also examine the benefits of year-round full-time operation of the

university, including whether year-round, full-time operation would increase the utilization
of physical facilities on the university's campus and save on the general costs of higher education.

(3) The study must be reported to the Legislative Assembly or appropriate committee on
 or before July 1, 2014.

12 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.

13 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 14 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 15 on its passage.
