House Bill 2185

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Education)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes adoption of fees for certain activities related to career schools. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

(4) All fees collected under this section shall be paid to the credit of the commission. Such
moneys are continuously appropriated to the commission and shall be used for the administration
of the licensing program under ORS 345.010 to 345.450.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> (1) The amendments to ORS 345.080 by section 3 of this 2013 Act become
 operative on July 1, 2015.

(2) Until the Higher Education Coordinating Commission first adopts rules pursuant to
 ORS 345.080 as amended by section 3 of this 2013 Act, the commission may collect the annual
 license fees established by ORS 345.080 as amended by section 2 of this 2013 Act.

18 SECTION 5. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 20 July 1, 2013.

21
