

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2387

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete line 27.
- 2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 31 and insert:
- 3 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Historical Society shall solicit donations and undertake a**
- 4 **fund-raising campaign to raise moneys for:**
- 5 **“(a) The selection of a sculptor and the commissioning of a design and the production**
- 6 **of a sculpture of Mark Odom Hatfield, including the creation of a pedestal and any desired**
- 7 **inscription;**
- 8 **“(b) The transportation of the statue and pedestal to the United States Capitol;**
- 9 **“(c) The temporary display of the statue in the Rotunda of the United States Capitol**
- 10 **during any unveiling ceremony to be held;**
- 11 **“(d) Other costs associated with the unveiling ceremony;**
- 12 **“(e) The costs of removal of the statue of Jason Lee from National Statuary Hall in the**
- 13 **United States Capitol, transportation of the Jason Lee statue to Salem, Oregon, and instal-**
- 14 **lation of the Jason Lee statue at a suitable location identified by the society; and**
- 15 **“(f) Any other expenses the society incurs in implementing this section.**
- 16 **“(2) Upon enactment of this section, the Executive Director of the Oregon Historical**
- 17 **Society, or the executive director’s designee, shall:**
- 18 **“(a) Undertake the fund-raising campaign described in subsection (1) of this section;**
- 19 **“(b) Within six months following enactment of this section, write to the Architect of the**
- 20 **Capitol apprising the architect of the interest of the State of Oregon in replacing the statue**
- 21 **of Jason Lee in National Statuary Hall in the United States Capitol with a statue of Mark**
- 22 **Odom Hatfield and requesting the architect to seek the approval of the Joint Committee on**
- 23 **the Library of Congress for the statue replacement; and**
- 24 **“(c) Convey all information received from the Architect of the Capitol about the statue**
- 25 **replacement project to the Governor or the Governor’s designee.**
- 26 **“(3) As soon as is practicable after the date on which the society determines that it has**
- 27 **obtained sufficient funding to undertake the project described in subsection (1) of this sec-**
- 28 **tion, the society shall seek proposals from qualified sculptors and undertake whatever other**
- 29 **measures are necessary to complete the project described in subsection (1) of this section.**
- 30 **The society shall follow the direction of the Architect of the Capitol in completing the project**
- 31 **described in subsection (1) of this section.”.**
