Modifies restriction on use of photographs taken using photo red light camera.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to photo red light; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 810.435.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 810.435 is amended to read:

5 810.435. (1) **Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section**, photographs taken under  
6 ORS 810.434 may be submitted into evidence in a **criminal trial, grand jury proceeding or other**  
7 **criminal proceeding for the purpose of proving or disproving a felony or a Class A**  
8 **misdemeanor.** [*administrative proceeding or other judicial or quasi-judicial proceeding only for the*  
9 *purpose of proving or disproving a violation of ORS 811.265.*]

10 (2) **Photographs taken under ORS 810.434 may not be used in any criminal proceeding**  
11 **relating to the prosecution of a violation as described in ORS 153.008, other than for the**  
12 **purpose of proving or disproving a violation of ORS 811.265.**

13 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 810.435 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to pho-  
14 **tographs taken on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.**
