

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2620

By COMMITTEE ON CONSUMER PROTECTION AND GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY

1 Delete lines 4 through 22 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Legislative Assembly finds that regional and community based**  
3 **problem solving requires that state agencies:**

4 **“(a) Work more collaboratively and in an integrated fashion with local governments,**  
5 **businesses and nonprofit corporations at the regional and community level.**

6 **“(b) Align state investments and technical assistance with priorities established at the**  
7 **regional and community level.**

8 **“(c) Maximize state services that are delivered at the regional and community level.**

9 **“(d) Minimize expenditures that do not provide direct services to Oregonians.**

10 **“(e) Use regional solution centers and regional solution teams to:**

11 **“(A) Support regional and community based mechanisms that integrate state and local**  
12 **resources and services; and**

13 **“(B) Engage private partners in problem solving.**

14 **“(f) Identify reforms that will advance the goals of reducing duplication, the fragmenta-**  
15 **tion of functions and costs to communities.**

16 **“(g) Utilize principles developed by state agencies to improve service delivery within**  
17 **available resources and in an innovative fashion.**

18 **“(2) The Governor, in coordination with the Director of the Oregon Department of Ad-**  
19 **ministrative Services, shall develop a plan to align state economic and community develop-**  
20 **ment programs with regional and community based development programs. The plan must**  
21 **propose changes in state programs that promote regional and community based problem**  
22 **solving as described in subsection (1) of this section while preserving state program objec-**  
23 **tives and the delivery of services by those programs.**

24 **“(3) The plan required under subsection (2) of this section is not subject to the**  
25 **rulemaking requirements of ORS chapter 183, but the Governor shall provide an opportunity**  
26 **for public review and engagement in developing the plan. The plan shall be submitted to the**  
27 **Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly for consideration during the 2014 regular session.**

28 **“(4) The Governor shall ensure that representatives of natural resource agencies partic-**  
29 **ipate in regional solution teams and are available at regional solution centers provided for**  
30 **in subsection (1)(e) of this section to the maximum extent possible.”.**

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
