On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 8 and 9 and insert: 1 2 "(B) One member who is a minority individual or a woman, as those terms are defined in ORS 3 200.005, who owns or operates a small or local business.". Delete lines 12 and 13 and insert: 4 "(B) One member who is a minority individual or a woman, as those terms are defined in ORS  $\mathbf{5}$ 200.005, who owns or operates a small or local business.". 6 7 Delete lines 15 and 16 and insert: "(A) One member who is a minority individual or a woman, as those terms are defined in ORS 8 9 200.005, who owns or operates a small or local business;". 10 On page 2, delete lines 3 through 10. In line 11, delete "(e)" and insert "(c)". 11 12 In line 12, delete the period and insert "; and 13 "(d) Report the results of the study the task force conducts under paragraph (a) of this sub-14 section in a manner that makes comprehensive data about public contracting awards to minority-15owned, woman-owned or emerging small businesses in this state visible, understandable and useable 16 and that illuminates the particular impact that contracting agencies' public contracting practices 17 have on: 18 "(A) Minority-owned businesses, woman-owned businesses and emerging small businesses, each 19 as separate categories of businesses; and 20 "(B) Specific groups of minority individuals who own small or local businesses, including but not 21limited to individuals who are: (i) Asian American, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(c), or Pacific Islander; 22"(ii) Black, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(a), or African American; 23 24 "(iii) Hispanic, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(b), or Latino; 25"(iv) Portuguese, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(d); "(v) American Indian or Alaskan Native, as described in ORS 200.005 (4)(e); and 2627"(vi) A member of another group that the Advocate for Minority, Women and Emerging Small 28Business has determined is socially and economically disadvantaged.". 29
